



## Statement of Compliance with California Assembly Bill 1584

<b><i>Paragraph/Provision</i></b>	<b><i>Compliance</i></b>
(1) A statement that pupil records continue to be the property of and under the control of the local educational agency.	Yes, per NextGenMath Privacy Policy.
(2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), a description of the means by which pupils may retain possession and control of their own pupil-generated content, if applicable, including options by which a pupil may transfer pupil-generated content to a personal account.	Yes, per NextGenMath Privacy Policy.
(3) A prohibition against the third party using any information in the pupil record for any purpose other than those required or specifically permitted by the contract.	Yes, per NextGenMath Privacy Policy.
(4) A description of the procedures by which a parent, legal guardian, or eligible pupil may review personally identifiable information in the pupil's records and correct erroneous information.	Yes, per NextGenMath Privacy Policy.
(5) A description of the actions the third party will take, including the designation and training of responsible individuals, to ensure the security and confidentiality of pupil records. Compliance with this requirement shall not, in itself, absolve the third party of liability in the event of an unauthorized disclosure of pupil records. (7) (A) A certification that a pupil's records shall not be retained or available to the third party upon completion of the terms of the contract and a description of how that certification will be enforced. (7) (B) The requirements provided in subparagraph (A) shall not apply to pupil-generated content if the pupil chooses to establish or maintain an account with the third party for the purpose of storing that content pursuant to paragraph (2).	Yes.
